EMT— Paramedic Program

The Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic (EMT-P) program is a 1,014 hour classroom and field-based emergency medical training program. This course is approved by the Michigan Dept. of Community Health EMS and Trauma Systems Section. Upon successful completion, students are eligible to take the National Registry Certification test as required by the State of Michigan for licensure.

This level of education is aimed at preparing students to enter into advanced level emergency response positions in ambulance service companies, fire departments, and as hospital emergency room technicians.

Prerequisite to this program is EMT-Basic and Anatomy and Physiology for Paramedics. Both are offered by the Hillsdale Training Center. More information regarding either of these can be obtained by contacting Dave Myers, Education Coordinator, at 517-607-4200.

What will I learn?

Classroom and homework will include lecture, hands-on practical and computer-based quizzes and exams. Students are required to have access to a reliable computer and Internet throughout the course. The program teaches, *but not limited to:*

- Advanced airway management, including surgical cricothyrotomy
- Advanced cardiac assessment and treatment, including 12 lead ECG interpretation
- Advanced cardiac life support certification (ACLS)
- Pharmacology
- A more comprehensive look at disease, including acid base balance and blood chemistry
- Dealing with more complex medical and traumatic life-threatening illness and injuries
- Assisting hospital personnel with more advanced care



What days and times are the classes?

Classes will be held Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6 to 10 p.m., along with several Saturday sessions which will begin at 9 a.m.

What is the cost of the program?

Tuition for the program is \$4,000, which includes the cost of the required books and the prerequisite class of Anatomy and Physiology for Paramedics. The A & P class will be provided for this program through Jackson Community College (JCC) at their Hillsdale Campus lab room, starting in January 2010. A \$100 discount will be given to Hillsdale County Emergency Services Departments and employees of HCHC.

Deposit of \$1,000 is required at the time of registration, with balance due by the start of class. Financial aid and/or payment arrangements may be available to those who qualify.
