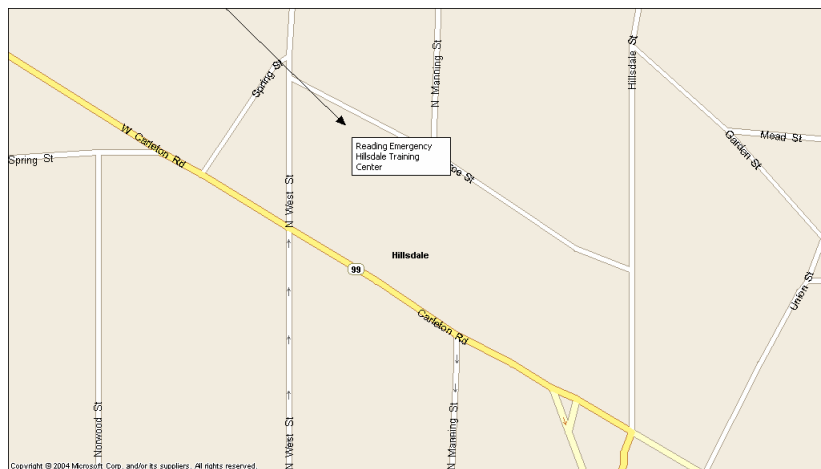

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## Medical First Responder (MFR)

The Medical First Responder program is designed for anyone interested in working in public safety, including fire and police departments. Students who successfully complete the program are eligible to take the National Registry examination for Medical First Responders. Upon successful completion of the NREMT examination, students will be eligible for licensure in the



state of Michigan. Total class hours are 106. This includes classroom instruction and clinical ambulance experience, allowing the student to put to work the classroom information he/she has received.



## Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

The Emergency Medical Technician program covers anatomy and physiology, comprehensive patient assessment and triage, airway management, oxygen therapy and emergency treatment of patient with bleeding, shock, cardiac arrest, fractures, spinal injuries, and other medical emergencies. The Emergency Medical Technician program is designed for anyone



interested in EMS. Students who successfully complete the program are eligible to take the National Registry Emergency Medical Technician examination. Upon successful completion of the NREMT examination, students

will be eligible for licensure in the state of Michigan. Total class hours are 224, including classroom instruction and clinical experience.

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## Emergency Medical Technician Specialist (EMT-S)

This program is designed for any EMT interested in becoming an Emergency Medical Technician Specialist. The program teaches advanced airway management, intravenous therapy, basic ECG, and reinforces core EMT skills. Students who successfully complete this program are eligible to take the National Registry for Emergency Medical Technician Specialist / Intermediate I-85 examination. Upon successful completion of the National Registry examination, students will be eligible for licensure in the state of Michigan. Total course hours are 136, which include classroom instruction, clinicals and internships.



## Paramedic (EMT-P)

This program is designed for any EMT interested in becoming an Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic. The program teaches advanced airway management, intravenous therapy, advanced ECG, advanced cardiac care, pharmacology, and reinforces core EMT skills. Students who successfully complete this program are eligible to take the National Registry for Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic examination. Upon successful completion of the National Registry examination, students will be eligible for licensure in the state of Michigan. Total course hours are approximately 1,000 hours, which includes classroom instruction, clinicals and internships.

## CPR and Immunization Status

Students are **required** to have these before clinicals. Proof will need to be provided by the first day of class.

- CPR Certification
- Current negative PPD-T (Tuberculosis / TB test)
- MMR (measles / mumps / rubella vaccine)
- Positive history of Varicella Zoster (chicken pox)
- Hepatitis B vaccine or signed waiver



## Supplies for all Programs
